				shall enter into a tripartite escrow agreement with the designated escrow agent, which will set out, interalia, the events of the release of the source code and the obligations of the escrow agent. Costs for the Escrow will be borne by the successful bidder. As a part of the escrow arrangement, the successful bidder is expected to provide a detailed code documentation of the chatbot software. The Escrow arrangement suggested by the successful bidder shall not be binding on the Bank. The Bank reserves the right to explore alternate escrow mechanisms based on the Bank's existing practices. The Bank and the successful bidder may enter into such escrow arrangement that is mutually agreed upon by the two parties. The source code of customizations done by the successful bidder on the latest version of the chatbot software running in the bank is to be kept in escrow once in a quarter. The escrow will be released to and become the property of the Bank in the event that the agreement is terminated for either default or insolvency or should the bidder cease, or give notice of intention to cease to provide maintenance or technical support service for the software as required by the agreement. All payment and costs with respect to lodging of software with escrow services in India would be borne by the successful bidder.
