MURDER PLOT GOES WRONG, 5 ARRESTED

Anakapalli police have taken five suspects into custody in a failed murder-for-hire case wherein a totally unrelated person ended up getting assaulted at his residence. The case registered under Section 109(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita at the S. Narayana Police Station involves a tangled network of racial conflicts and financial disputes.

Police sources said the murder had been planned by Mediseti Nookeswari (26), who fell trapped in a legal case of divorce from her husband for the last three years. A local journalist Rudra had taken money and 6.5 tons of gold from Nookeswari to support her in legal matters against her estranged husband. But Rudra neither helped get the divorce nor returned the money and gold.

Following this, Nookeswari, along with her purported lover Barre Pediraju (44), allegedly engaged three young men to eliminate Rudra in Thimmapuram village.

On July 11, 2025, at approximately 6.30 p.m., Nookeswari and Pediraju took the hired killers Sagar Samireddy (18), Kesavaji Jaisa Prasad (26), and Rayudu Raju Kumar (18) to the Adda Road Bridge and pointed to Rudra's home, promising to pay ₹1 lakh once the killing had been done. The three drank alcohol and at approximately 9.30 p.m. mistakenly entered the wrong house, where they found two women and a man sleeping.

The hired killers started assaulting the men. 41-year-old Egnapati Nagavara Rao, with an iron rod.

When the women cried out, the attackers fled the scene. They then met Nookeswari and Pediraju insisting on payment after asserting that they had completed their task. Nookeswari then called Rudra to check out and found that the assailants had targeted the wrong person.

Police investigations revealed that Pediraju had a connection with known criminals. The three hired killers too had cases registered against them at Tuni Rural and Tuni Town police stations for theft, assault and other criminal offences.

Tribals still lack basic services in Anakapalli

612 ration card holders trek 13 km to transport ration

Tribal communities across several highland villages in Anakapalli district, including Jagampeta, Pedapuruvu, Rayavada, Rochoi, Paniko, Tatiparthi, Gangampeta, Neredu Banda, Z. Jagampeta, Ajjapuram, Karlagadda, and Bangaru Bandu, are facing severe hardships in accessing essential services, particularly ration, mobile connectivity and children's infrastructure.

Z. Jagampeta is central to all these villages. The 612 ration card holders have to walk nearly 13 kilometres to reach the Kalyandura GOC ration depot located in Ravikamatham mandal to collect their monthly supplies for sustenance.

According to CPIM leader K. Govinda Rao, ration has previously been distributed directly in villages. However, since the NDA coalition

government assumed office, the system has been dismantled. Tribal residents have to trek long to collect rations, often carrying heavy loads on their heads and shoulders during the return journey.

Community members are urging the government to establish a GOC ration depot in Jagampeta to restore accessibility and dignity. Mobile connectivity remains unreliable across these villages. Signals are accessible in only one or two isolated spots, as most cell towers in the area are inactive.

Vandana Chitravathi, a resident, highlights the urgent need to activate all cell towers in the area to ensure basic communication and access to digital services. The region's children's infrastructure is equally strained. A single Anganwadi centre in Z. Jagampeta currently serves all 11 surrounding villages, including Pedapuruvu, Rayapuruvu, Rochoi, Paniko, Tatiparthi, Gangampeta, Neredu Banda, Ajjapuram, Karlagadda, and Bangaru Bandu. This limited coverage undermines early childhood nutrition and maternal support in a region already grappling with systemic neglect.

Residents, such as Puniti Bhaskara Rao from Ajjapuram, describe the physical strain of transporting rations using makeshift carts across rough terrain.

They want establishment of an anganwadi centre, highlighting a broader demand for basic infrastructure and recognition of their rights.

The historical city of Rajamahendravaram in East Godavari district has been frequently facing inundation whenever rains heavily in particular, there are three places where waterlogging continues for over 24 hours after it rains. To prevent this happening, engineers have suggested construction of five drains at a cost of ₹15 crore to address the problem permanently. But lack of finances has delayed these drains.

Sources said Godavari Pushkaralu are expected in 2027, a major event spread over 12 days in which eight crore people from all over the country and world are expected to participate. The Pushkaralu are scheduled in July, which is a month when Godavari River floods flows.

Officials and people are hoping that the state government, in particular, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, will release the funds keeping in view the problems devotees will face, which may tarnish the image of the state. "Unless the new drains are constructed, there will be no solution to inundation," an official remarked.

EIGHT HELD IN HIGHWAY MURDER CASE

Eight individuals have been arrested in connection with the murder of a 41-year-old man, Sethi Ramu, near Koyirallu Centre along the service road of National Highway 16 in Etcherla Mandal, Srikulam District, on July 11.

Police said Ramu was attacked while having tea with friends after visiting the MPDO office to submit housing applications. Two motorbikes approached, and the assailants surrounded Ramu and stabbed him repeatedly. He died on the spot due to severe blood loss, and the attackers fled.

Police said the murder stemmed from a faction feud in the same village. The case was reported to Etcherla Police Station at 5:00 p.m. on the same day. Based on intelligence, police conducted a search near ITT Grounds and arrested all eight accused, recovering the weapons used.

The accused - Kotteti Srinivasa Rao (37), Kotteti Suresh (25), Kotteti Bhaskar Kumar (25), Kotteti Apparao (27), Kotteti Naresh (27), Kotteti Siva Kumar (25), Prada Ranga Swamy (30), and Gundamala Bhavani (25) - are residents of Paroodyala village. They were produced before the local magistrate and remanded. A case has been registered under Crime No. 186-2025 under Section 109(1) read with Section 48 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita. Ramu's body was sent to KIMS Hospital for post-mortem.

Even as these plans are being conceived, Sewage Treatment Plant works in the city have come to a halt. The contractor has completed 50 per cent of the work and the municipal corporation has paid 30 per cent of the amount.

5 drains to stop floods in R'varam, say engineers

Former BJP state president and MLC Somu Veerajulu has asserted that the proposed Rajamahendravaram drainage project will not adversely affect Telangana's water resources. Veerajulu said only surplus water that would otherwise flow into the sea would be utilised under the project.

He urged Telangana to cooperate with Andhra Pradesh and called on all political parties in AP to support the alliance government's efforts.

Veerajulu also criticised former chief minister N. Chandrababu Naidu for allegedly using threatening language to power in 2020, stating that the Constitution does not allow such actions. He pointed out that several officials who supported Naidu had ended up in jail and accused the previous government (2019-2024) of fostering an anarchic regime.

Taking a dig at Naidu, Veerajulu mocked, "If people give him power again, will he buy sheep at ₹420 or ₹420?" He warned that unless Naidu changed his tone and approach, the BJP would respond strongly. He also questioned Naidu's repeated claims about state debt, alleging that social pension increases from ₹2,000 to ₹3,000 during the previous regime were financed.

Minister reviews SEZ investments

Industries, commerce, and food processing minister P.G. Bhavani stated that major investments are flowing into Andhra Pradesh under the leadership of Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu.

During his visit to the Achyutapuram Special Economic Zone (APSEZ) in Anakapalli district, the minister reviewed progress of ongoing projects along with APIC zone officials and engineers from the head office.

He discussed developments in the bulk drug cluster at Nakkapalli, updates on NS projects, and the ongoing Green Hydrogen project within the SEZ. The minister also evaluated
