

# Chemical test proves doubts of pilferage of gold in Sabarimala temple, says court

THE Kerala High Court on Monday observed that the chemical analysis of the samples collected from Sabarimala prima facie reinforced its doubts that the original gold-clad dwarapalakas and door frames from the temple were replaced.

The court, citing the analysis reports from the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC), noted that the original gold-clad plates didn't have nickel and acrylic polymer layers, whereas the layers were present in the subsequently-plated copper plates. This, along with the absence of mercury and compara-



tive thickness of the gold and nickel layers in the latter, clearly indicated a systematic and methodical process behind the execution of the alleged offence (of gold theft), the court said.

It said the reports not only disclose the manner and modus operandi of the alleged tampering and substitution, but also provide critical evidentiary pointers for correlating past

transactions with subsequent activities.

The report, therefore, assumes central importance in the probe as it sheds light on multiple technical and material aspects and furnishes a scientific basis for evaluating transactions undertaken during 2024 and 2025, identifying the chain of decision-making, fixing individual responsibility and criminal liability, and examining the existence of any organised or concerted action amounting to criminal conspiracy. However, the court refrained from disclosing additional technical particulars at this stage, noting the possibility of further arrests and recoveries.

## DMK governments over the years have built 43 dams across the state, says Stalin

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THE project is intended to increase the city's total storage capacity by roughly 15% and meet the growing demands of fast-developing areas.

Highlighting the features of the project, Stalin said the surplus water from a network of 69 lakes in and around the Manamathi area and other minor clusters, which would otherwise drain into the sea, will be diverted to the Mamallan reservoir. The CM added that the project will also help store fresh water in areas such as Thiruvandanthi, Kokilamedu, Mamallapuram, Tirupur, Thandalam and Paiyanur. This will prevent seawater intrusion and improve both groundwater level and quality.

As part of the plan, the Buckingham Canal in the region will be restored over a length of 15km, covering an area of 311 acres. This will improve the livelihood of fishermen who depend on brackish water fishing. Fishermen living in the area will also be issued fishing

licences, he said. Stalin noted that Chennai currently depends on Chembarambakkam, Puzhal, Cholavaram and Pooni reservoirs along with the newly-built Theruvai kandigai. With the addition of Mamallan, the city's water storage capacity will improve. It may be noted that Mamallan is expected to be larger than Cholavaram in terms of capacity and will be smaller than the other three reservoirs.

Explaining the reason for naming the reservoir as Mamallan, Stalin said, "The Pallavas ruled the Tondai region with Kancheepuram as their capital from the third to the ninth century CE. During this time, they created 39 lakes, including those at Mahendravadi, Uthiramerur, Thenneri, and Thooisi Mamandur to ensure food and water security through a structured lake administration system".

As the new reservoir is coming up near Mamallapuram, which was built by Pallava King Narasimhavarman popu-

larly known as "Mamallan", it was appropriate to name it the Mamallan reservoir, the CM said.

"Some criticise that we have not contributed much for improving water resources in the state. Former CM M Karunanidhi has done a lot. Till 2011, DMK governments over the years have built 43 dams across the state," he added. Apart from opening the Mettur Dam on time to facilitate agricultural activities, the present DMK government has ensured the desilting of waterbodies in the Cauvery delta region to the tune of ₹459 crore and built 121 check dams, the CM said.

Stalin further said the government is happy to present the Best Water Conservation Award to NGOs playing a key role in ensuring sustainable water resource management.

Deputy CM Udhayanidhi Stalin, ministers, Chengalpattu Collector D Sneha and officials from the Water Resources Department took part.

## Gang robs cash, gold worth ₹5 cr from bank in daring Odisha heist

IN a daring heist, armed robbers decamped with gold jewellery worth over ₹5 crore along with cash by holding staff and customers at gunpoint in the Bank of

Maharashtra branch of Barbil in Keonjhar district on Monday. The incident took place around 2.05 pm when about five to six masked robbers entered the bank branch located along Barbil-Kalinga state highway and carried out the entire plan in just about 15-20 minutes. The bank branch is located near the Truck Owners Association office.

Police sources said, just two bank staff and a handful of customers were present when the robbers walked in. Holding the bank staff at gunpoint, the robbers collected the mobile phones of all the customers. The helmet wearing miscreants then locked them inside a room and forced the branch manager to open the locker where mortgaged gold jewellery was kept. Before leaving, they also took away the CCTV recorder, but returned the mobile phones to the customers and bank staff. Since the bank primarily offers goal loans, the robbers are believed to have targeted the branch. They are likely to have chosen the immediate post-lunch hours to rob the bank since attendance is generally thin around the time. Also, there was no security guard present at the branch when the incident

took place.

On receiving information, Keonjhar SP Nitin Kushalkar Dagdu along with a team rushed to the spot. He questioned the bank employees and the customers present at the branch. Roads connecting to the area were sealed off to prevent escape by the robbers. It is suspected that the robbers might have taken the road to Jharkhand as it is very close to Barbil town. According to the Barbil police, all banks of the town had been clearly advised in a joint meeting held during December 2025, to install hidden cameras, dummy DVR and frontage camera. They were also instructed to save data in cloud format and deploy armed guards in compliance to standard operating procedures issued by DIG, Western range.

Police are verifying whether the guidelines were maintained at the bank. While a search operation has been launched, police are closely examining the CCTV footage of the surrounding areas.

## 'K'taka DGP's sleazy video' goes viral, Siddu promises action

BENGALURU: A video purportedly showing Karnataka DGP (Civil Rights Enforcement) K Ramachandra Rao in an alleged compromising position with women went viral in the social media on Monday.

Rao sought to reject the videos outright terming them "fabricated and false." Chief Minister Siddaramaiah warned of action if the official was found guilty. The DGP's attempt to clarify his position with Home Minister G Parameshwara did not fructify. The top police officer is the stepfather of Harshavardhini Ranya alias Ranya Rao, arrested in a sensational gold smuggling case and currently lodged in the Bengaluru Central Jail.

Kannada TV news channels too aired the blurred images of women in the video.

Chief Minister Siddaramaiah said, "We will get it investigated." "I got to know about it in the morning. We will initiate disciplinary action against him. No one is above law, notwithstanding how senior the police officer is," he said responding the controversy surrounding the Director General of Police.

As the videos went viral, Rao rushed to meet Parameshwara but the meeting did not take place.

Speaking to reporters outside the minister's house, he said, "I am also thinking how and when it happened and who has done it. In this era anything can happen. I have no idea about it."
